

The National Conference for College Women Student Leaders (NCCWSL) is an annual conference sponsored by the American Association of University Women (AAUW) and Student Affairs Administrators in Higher Education (NASPA) focused on developing successful female leaders. Women gather from throughout the nation to discuss and learn about contemporary issues facing leaders.

NCCWSL has grown rapidly since its founding more than three decades ago, attracting over 10,000 student leaders. In 2019 the conference brought together 800 attendees representing 48 states and over 300 colleges and universities. The diversity of backgrounds and ideas at NCCWSL is part of what makes it such a transformative experience. The workshops, panels, speakers and activities provide endless opportunities to learn from experts, while peer networking allows one to learn from one another and make lifelong connections

This year, May 25-26, 2021, AAUW invited hundreds of college women to this conference from around the country for two days of virtual leadership training, inspiration and networking.
